In 2010, fifteen swim teams with nearly 600 swimmers and their fans visited Milford over the course of this two day event. Well over 50% of the athletes improved their times in at least one event during last year's meet. The Milford Rotary Club is committed to maintaining this meet as a "no entry fee" event.
